



SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDELINES AND UNIFORM PRICE LIST



Information for Students and Parents

Effective 15 December 2025.

Rockingham Senior High School Education Support Centre's Uniform Guidelines were developed in accordance with the Department of Education Dress Codes for Student in Public Schools Guidelines.

There is an expectation that all students comply with the dress requirements and understand that wearing of the school uniform is compulsory. Individual needs based on disability will be considered and appropriate adjustments to the school uniform requirements made. Individual adjustments to uniform expectations based on individual needs must be endorsed by the School Principal, in consultation with parent/carers. These adjustments will be documented in the Student Profile.

The school uniform dress code:

- Ensures the safety of student through easy identification.
- Promotes a positive school image.
- Engenders a sense of school pride.
- Encourages equity amongst students.
- Prepares students for the workplace, where conformity to dress and safety codes is expected.

Years 7-12 Uniform

All students to wear:

- School shirt/blouse

Students then have a choice of:

- Black (plain) skirt/shorts/track pants/pants.
- RSHS ESC unisex soft-shell jacket.
- School dress uniform.

***Skirts, shorts and dresses must be worn at a modest length.**

Please Note: "Modest" = covering 2/3 of upper leg area.

Additional Information:

- **Enclosed footwear** must be worn by all students.
- **Leavers jackets** – Year 11/12's only, may be worn in place of school jacket.
- **Black tights/leggings** can be worn under skirts/school dress.
- **Students attending workplace learning (WPL)** are required to wear suitable clothing and PPE as required by individual WPL documentation.
- **Uniform and WPL attire should be clean.**
- **Socks need to be worn with enclosed shoes.**
- During the **colder weather** students can layer with undergarments to stay warm as long as the outer most layer is the correct school shirt or jacket. Plain black, grey, white or red jumpers/windcheaters/thermals can be worn under the school shirt. Please note that hoodies are not part of the uniform and should not be worn at all unless a uniform exemption is approved due to a student's sensory or individual needs.

Physical Education Uniform:

All students are required to change into their PE uniform (**their House/Faction colour**) for all PE lessons and change into their day uniform at the conclusion of the PE lesson.

The PE uniform consists of:

- House (faction) polo.
- Black shorts.
- Sports sneakers.
- Hats are encouraged.

Bushrangers Uniform:

All students involved in Bushrangers may wear their Bushrangers polo for the day they attend Bushranger classes.

Non-compliance with Uniform Guidelines:

Students not wearing the correct uniform will be given the choice of borrowing an item of clothing from the school or contacting their parent/carer to bring the correct uniform to school. At the end of the school day, students are required to leave their borrowed uniform at the Front Office.

Persistent noncompliance with the Uniform Guidelines will result in a meeting with parents/carers, the student, and the School Principal.

Excursions:

Unless otherwise stated, students will be expected to wear their full school uniform on excursions, or as otherwise outlined in excursion documentation.

Make-up, jewellery and body adornments:

Make-up, jewellery and body adornments must be safe and appropriate (e.g. small sleepers and studs). If in the opinion of school administration, a student does not adhere to these guidelines, they will be required to make the necessary changes to uphold the school uniform guidelines.

Students accessing external or community events and venues (e.g. workplace learning or TAFE) are required to follow rules and expectations of the external provider.

Responsibility for Supporting School Uniform Guidelines:

Parents/carers, students and staff work together to ensure that students understand the Uniform Guidelines and the importance of complying with them.

Parents/carers are responsible for ensuring students have the correct uniform when attending school. Parent/carers are responsible for communicating with class teachers when a student may not be able to attend school with a correct uniform due to family circumstances or individual needs related to the student's disability.

Class teachers are responsible for monitoring compliance and communicating with parents/carers and students if expectations for wearing school uniform are not met. Class teachers are also responsible for communicating with Student Services if there are concerns around uniform expectations and compliance for individual students.

Student Services staff are responsible for working with teachers, students and parents/carers to support compliance to the Uniform Guidelines and for resolving persistent noncompliance issues.

School Administration are responsible for ensuring the guidelines are followed by the school community.
